

Goldberg v. Mount Sinai Medical Center of Greater Miami, Inc.
07-1210-BKC-LMI

The Court issued an Order to Show Cause why attorney appearing pro hac vice should not be suspended from practicing before the Court following inappropriate comment and behavior. The Court has an inherent right - in fact, duty - to protect the integrity of the judicial process. The nature and extent of the appropriate response to inappropriate behavior is left to the discretion of the judge, measured by the conduct at issue as well as the attorney's response to the censure.

Attorney's filing of a certificate of completion evidencing the he did, in fact, attend a five hour on-line professionalism course offered by the Florida Bar, was sufficient to discharge Order to Show Cause.
