

**IN RE: SHAZARD MOHAMMED,
Debtor. 07-12303-BKC-LMI**

When a homestead property consists of more than one adjoining parcel, a debtor is entitled to take the homestead exemption for the entire property to the extent that the adjoining parcels are contiguous, that the acreage limitation is not exceeded, and such property would otherwise be exempt pursuant to Florida homestead law. Whether a parcel qualifies as homestead property is determined by looking at its use as of the date of filing.
