Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 722, a debtor may only redeem property that was part of the estate as of the petition date. Goods that were purchased and given as gifts to non-household members in which debtor has no interest other than an ongoing obligation to pay may not be redeemed by the debtor because they are neither exempt property nor property that was scheduled and subsequently abandoned by the trustee.
