The plaintiff filed an adversary complaint to determine nondischargeability of a debt arising from a contempt judgment for the defendant's failure to comply with a Pennsylvania court order concerning discovery, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 523(a)(6) and 523(a)(7). The plaintiff filed a motion for summary judgment as to the 523(a)(7) claim. The Court granted the summary judgment in favor of the defendant because the debt created by the contempt judgment against the defendant was payable to the Plaintiff, a private party, and not to a governmental unit.
