Florida Auctioneer Recovery Fund as required by Florida Statute 468.392. In addition,

summarizing the results of the auction and stating the fees and expenses which will be paid

to Auctioneer in accordance with the Order approving the retention. The report shall be

served only on the U.S. Trustee, the trustee and any other interested party who specifically requests a copy. The fees and expenses will be paid without the necessity of further notice or hearing unless any party in interest files an objection within 14 days from the filing of the report with the court and service of the report on the above parties.

WHEREFORE, trustee moves for the entry of an order granting this Application, approving the retention and compensation of Auctioneer upon the terms and conditions stated herein.
