In conformity with the rate established by the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, and in accordance with Local Rule 9019-2(A)(6), the Court hereby **ORDERS** as follows:

1. The compensation rate for qualified mediators selected or appointed pursuant to an "Order of Referral to Mediation" entered after the entry date of this Administrative Order shall be \$250.00 per hour and the compensation rate for all previously selected or appointed mediators shall remain as \$175.00 per hour unless (1) a different rate is or was agreed to in writing by the parties and the mediator selected by the parties; or (2) the matter is or was being mediated pro bono, in whole or in part, pursuant to Local Rule 9019-2(A)(2)(d).

2. This Order replaces Administrative Order 98-2 "ORDER ESTABLISHING NEW COMPENSATION RATE FOR MEDIATORS AND CLARIFYING EFFECTIVE DATE OF NEW RATE".
