**Adoption of Revised Schedule
of Transcript Rates**


At its March 2018 meeting, the Judicial Conference approved a new 3-day transcript delivery category, defined as “a transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of an order,” with rates of \$5.45 per page for original transcript, \$1.05 per first copy page, and \$0.75 per additional copy page to the same party.

The Judicial Conference also approved language clarifying the definitions of daily, hourly, and realtime transcripts. The new language removes references to “adjournment” and “unusual circumstances,” for tolling delivery time. As a result of this clarification, the definitions for all transcript categories and rates are now applicable based on when a transcript is ordered from the court reporter, not when the underlying proceeding ended.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that effective immediately, the court adopts the attached “Schedule of Transcript Rates,” in accordance with the maximum transcript rates established by the Judicial Conference.

It is further **ORDERED** that this order replaces and abrogates Administrative Order 07-08, for purposes of establishing the current transcript rates in effect in this court.

**NOTICE OF JUDICIAL CONFERENCE
MAXIMUM TRANSCRIPT RATES
EFFECTIVE APRIL 25, 2018**

<p><u>Ordinary Transcript (30 day)</u> A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.</p>	\$3.65	\$.90	\$.60
<p><u>14-Day Transcript</u> A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.</p>	\$4.25	\$.90	\$.60
<p><u>Expedited Transcript (7 day)</u> A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.</p>	\$4.85	\$.90	\$.60
<p><u>3-Day Transcript</u> A transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of an order.</p>	\$5.45	\$1.05	\$.75
<p><u>Daily Transcript</u> A transcript to be delivered on the calendar day following receipt of the order (regardless of whether that calendar day is a weekend or holiday), prior to the normal opening hour of the clerk's office.</p>	\$6.05	\$1.20	\$.90
<p><u>Hourly Transcript</u> A transcript of proceedings to be delivered within two (2) hours from receipt of the order.</p>	\$7.25	\$1.20	\$.90
<p><u>Realtime Transcript</u> A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following receipt of the order.</p>	One feed, ¹ \$3.05 per page; two-to-four feeds, \$2.10 per page; five or more feeds, \$1.50 per page.		

¹ A realtime "feed" is the electronic data flow from the court reporter to the computer of each person or party ordering and receiving the realtime transcription in the courtroom.
