ORDER

ORDER CLARIFYING GENERAL ORDER 2017-02

Due to Hurricane Irma, the Court entered General Order 2017-02, extending statutory deadlines and statutes of limitation. It has come to the attention of the Court that there is some confusion regarding the meaning and extent of the General Order. In order to avoid a drain on judicial resources addressing these alleged ambiguities on a case by case basis, it is

ORDERED as follows:

1. With respect to all bankruptcy cases pending in the Southern District of Florida on September 12, 2017, and, subject to the limitations in paragraphs 2 and 3 below, all deadlines of any kind, including, but not limited to, deadlines set by statute or Rule, are extended to October 12, 2017, unless the Court sets an earlier date by separate Order.
2. Deadlines that expired before September 7, 2017, are not extended.
3. This Order does not apply to any deadlines set by individual scheduling orders entered by the Court in connection with the scheduling of evidentiary hearings or trials. Parties seeking to extend these deadlines must file motions.
