**Status of Interim Bankruptcy Rules
Adopted by Administrative Order 05-4
Upon 12/1/08 Effective Date of Amended
Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure**

This court's Administrative Order 05-4 "Adoption of Interim Bankruptcy Rules" was entered on October 6, 2005, and provided that the Interim Bankruptcy Rules adopted by that order would remain in effect until further order of the court. The following new rules and amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure will take effect on December 1, 2008:

Bankruptcy Rules 1005, 1006, 1007, 1009, 1010, 1011, 1015, 1017, 1019, 1020, 2002, 2003, 2007.1, 2015, 3002, 3003, 3016, 3017.1, 3019, 4002, 4003, 4004, 4006, 4007, 4008, 5001, 5003, 6004, 7012, 7022, 7023.1, 8001, 8003, 9006, 9009, and 9024, and new Bankruptcy Rules 1021, 2007.2, 2015.1, 2015.2, 2015.3, 5008, and 6011.


The above rule amendments and new rules implement the substantive and procedural changes to the Bankruptcy Code made by the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (Pub. L. No. 109-08, 119 Stat. 23). The amendments and new rules, with the exception of Interim Bankruptcy Rule 5012 (which was not included in the December 1, 2008 amendments), supersede the Interim Bankruptcy Rules adopted by this court's Administrative Order 05-4. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that on December 1, 2008, except for Interim Bankruptcy Rule 5012, which shall remain in effect in this court, the Interim Bankruptcy Rules adopted by Administrative Order 05-4, shall be replaced by the amended Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure which take effect on December 1, 2008.

As provided by Local Rule 1001-1(F)(2), where an Interim Bankruptcy Rule is cited in the local rules and that Interim Bankruptcy Rule is subsequently adopted as a

Bankruptcy Rule, the use of "Interim Bankruptcy Rule" shall mean the Bankruptcy Rule as subsequently adopted.
