

**Order Adopting Amended Interim
Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I**

On December 10, 2008, this court entered Administrative Order 08-4, "Adoption of Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I." Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I implemented the National Guard and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008, which excludes certain members of the National Guard and Reserves from means testing in chapter 7 bankruptcy cases commenced in the three-year period beginning December 19, 2008.

Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I was amended by Administrative Order 09-7, "Order Adopting Amended Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I," to incorporate changes in time deadlines resulting from amendments to the Bankruptcy Rules effective December 1, 2009.

On December 1, 2010, amendments to the Bankruptcy Rules will take effect which include an amendment to Bankruptcy Rule 1007 extending the time to file the statement of completion of a course in personal financial management in a chapter 7 case filed by an individual debtor from 45 days after the first date set for the meeting of creditors to 60 days after the first date set for the meeting of creditors. Amended Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I also includes this change in deadline. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that, effective December 1, 2010:

1. Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I, as adopted by this court in Administrative Order 08-4 and subsequently amended by Administrative Order 09-7, is further amended to reflect the December 1, 2010 amendment to Bankruptcy Rule 1007, changing the deadline to file the statement of completion of a course in personal financial management in a chapter 7 case filed by an individual debtor from 45 days after the first date set for the meeting of creditors to 60 days after the first date set for the meeting of creditors. A copy of amended Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I is attached as Exhibit A.

2. This Order supersedes and replaces Administrative Order 09-7.
