Bankruptcy Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule Increases Effective December 1, 2014

At its September 2014 session, the Judicial Conference approved several changes to the federal court miscellaneous fee schedules, including the following amendments to the Bankruptcy Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule which are effective December 1, 2014:

[Item 14] Fee Increase of \$50 (from \$157 to \$207) when a direct bankruptcy appeal or cross appeal is accepted by a court of appeals. This adjustment brings parity to the fees for appealing a bankruptcy court order in a court of appeals.

[Item 21] New Fee Established of \$25 to file a motion to make redactions to previously filed records in a bankruptcy case. ([See Administrative Order 14-06](#)).

[Item 11] Endorsed New Exception to the reopening fee for a closed bankruptcy case to clarify that the reopening fee does not apply if redaction is the only purpose for reopening the case. ([See Administrative Order 14-06](#)).
