Adoption of
Interim Local Rule 2016-1(B)(1)

This Court's "Guidelines for Fee Applications for Professionals in the Southern District of Florida in Bankruptcy Cases" ("Guidelines") were amended effective December 1, 2015 in conjunction with the entry of Administrative Order 15-04, "Adoption of Amended Local Rules and Clarification of Status of Local Forms, Court Guidelines, Clerk's Instructions, and Administrative Orders".

The December 1, 2015 amendments to the "Guidelines" included a revision which provided that "applications for cumulative compensation that do not exceed \$5,000 need not include a breakdown by categories of work performed". As a result of a scrivener's error, a corresponding amendment to Local Rule 2016-1(B)(1) was not adopted to conform to the increased amount of cumulative compensation adopted in the amended "Guidelines". Accordingly, it is

ORDERED as follows:

(1) Local Rule 2016-1(B)(1) is amended in section (B)(1) by substituting the following as Interim Local Rule 2016-1(B)(1):

(B) Requirements for Compensation.

(1) Applications for Compensation for Professional Services or Reimbursement of Expenses other than by Attorneys for Chapter 13 Debtors. Applications for compensation of attorneys (other than by attorneys for chapter 13 debtors), accountants, and other professionals submitted pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2016 shall comply with the court's "Guidelines for Fee Applications for Professionals in the Southern District of Florida" and the local forms described in the guidelines. Applications for compensation by creditors' attorneys, other than under 11 U.S.C. §503(b)(2), (3) and (4), are not governed by this subdivision but may be incorporated into the creditor's claim, request for payment of administrative expense, or motion to determine value of secured claim.

(2) The Clerk is directed to provide notice of entry of this Order and to update the Local Rules as published by this court to reflect amended Interim Local Rule 2016-1(B)(1).
