Order Regarding Certain Deadlines

Administrative Order 2020-05

On March 16, 2020, The Office of the United States Trustee issued a notice (the "UST Notice"), rescheduling all in-person section 341 meetings scheduled through April 10, 2020 in chapter 7, 12 and 13 cases.

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 105, in order to carry out the provisions of the Bankruptcy Code and to implement appropriately certain deadlines in the Bankruptcy Code and in the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules") during this time of national emergency, it is

ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The "first date set for the meeting of creditors under 11 U.S.C. § 341(a)" as used in the Bankruptcy Rules shall be the rescheduled date of all meetings of creditors continued by the UST Notice (the "Rescheduled First Meeting Date").
- 2. The deadlines set under Bankruptcy Rules 1007(c), 1017(e)(1), 2002(h), 2015.3(b), 4004(a), 4007(c) and 4008(a) shall be calculated from the Rescheduled First Meeting Date.
- 3. "[T]he date on which the meeting of creditors is first scheduled to be held" pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1308 (a) shall be the Rescheduled First Meeting Date for all chapter 13 § 341 meetings continued by the UST Notice.
- 4. The deadlines under Bankruptcy Rule 2003(c) for holding § 341 meetings are extended to the extent necessary to accommodate the postponement of the § 341 meetings by the Office of the United States Trustee or order of this Court.
