**Order Establishing a New Compensation Rate For  
Mediators and Clarifying Effective Date of New Rate**

---

In conformity with the rate established by the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida and in accordance with Local Rule 9019-2(A)(6), the Court **ORDERS** as follows:

1. The compensation rate for qualified mediators selected or appointed pursuant to an “Order of Referral to Mediation” entered after the entry date of this Administrative Order shall be \$350 per hour, and the compensation rate for all previously selected or appointed mediators shall remain as \$250 per hour unless (1) a different rate is or was agreed to in writing by the parties and the mediator selected by the parties; or (2) the matter is or was being mediated pro bono, in whole or in part, pursuant to Local Rule 9019-2(A)(2)(b).
  
2. This Order supersedes and replaces Administrative Order 08-2 “Order Establishing New Compensation Rate For Mediators and Clarifying Effective Date of New Rate”.
