President Donald Trump has declared Wednesday, December 5, 2018, as a day of mourning for former President George H. W. Bush. The President's declaration means that all federal offices will be closed. Therefore, the United States Bankruptcy Court will be **CLOSED** **Wednesday, December 5, 2018**, in honor of former President Bush.

This closure affects the Bankruptcy Court's operations in Miami, Fort Lauderdale and West Palm Beach which will be closed to the public.

All court hearings scheduled on Wednesday, December 5, 2018, are cancelled and will be rescheduled. In addition, any § 341 meeting of creditors scheduled before the trustee or Office of the U.S. trustee in a bankruptcy case in this district is also cancelled and will be rescheduled.

The court will resume normal business operations on Thursday, December 6, 2018.
